Great things come in threes.

The Trinity. Morning, noon and night. Breakfast, lunch and dinner. Jesus' inner circle – Peter, James and John. Tripods. Tricycles. Most clover leaves. And...

The three new features I'm excited to tell you about in this month's letter.

1-Connect

Because we are made in the image of the Trinity, we are – all of us – deeply relational beings. Made to connect. Made to walk alongside one another, made to need someone else in our foxhole. This is even *more* true when we begin to understand the weight of the Larger Story, the battle for our hearts and the times in which we live. But often it's hard to find folks who want what you want, true allies. Till now.

Across the U.S. and all around the world, men and women are gathering together to go deeper in the Ransomed Heart message – to pursue a deeper intimacy with Jesus, further restoration in their own lives, to join in the Larger Story of battling for the hearts and lives of others, to bring Jesus as he really is to the world. Bible studies, weekend events, retreats, small groups, churches centered around this gospel, and counselors working from this perspective. Some of those allies are right in your neighborhood.

2-Pray

I know, I know – every ministry says, "We need your prayers." The typical response to the hurried conversation after church is, "I'll pray for you." We all give a nod to prayer, but frankly very little happens after that.

Not here, not in this Great Battle.

We live by the power of prayer; we advance the Kingdom in staggering ways by the power of prayer. Just this past weekend we had a phenomenal women's event – the Captivating Advanced. Honestly, I have never seen so much profound healing, restoration and breakthrough in one weekend (and we've seen some pretty incredible weekends!). It happened in great part because of prayer. Your prayers.
